




- 6061 Alum Spools lathed from solid stock, anodized.
- 304 Stainless Steel Housing formed from one piece.
- 1/4 " 316 Stainless Steel Shaft.
- 2 oil light Bronze Bearings 1/4" x 1/2" x 3/8".
- Non rotating Brass Fixture on the inside.
- Spring Steel Discs.
- 6061 Alum Tension Control, anodized.
- 6061 Alum Handles, anodized.
- 6061 Alum or 316 Stainless Steel Handle Shaft.

The Trout Special weighs 5.8 oz.
Both Spools combined, 3 1/8" H and 1 1/4 "W.
The Housing is 3 1/2 "at the longest point.

Line holders come with each reel to keep the
line secure on the spool not in use.

DUAL DRAG SYSTEM COMPRESSION DRAG

The new compression drag on the inside has a stationary series of curved discs that do not rotate or spin and is compressed against a non-movable brass fixture. The compression Drag operates the same in both directions. This makes the TWIN either right or left hand. (Mount the reel the opposite direction and load the line.) The compression drag is completely silent and is sufficient for playing out a large variety of fresh water fish.

The tension control tightens clockwise and when backed all the way off, the spool spins free.

The Compression Drag is part of the Patent and is a technical assembly that Does Not Disassemble. If assembled incorrectly it will not operate properly. This is why the Reel is one Unit and welded together. The entire reel is patented with 18 different claims. The Compression Drag along with all the parts on the Twin Spool Reel is fully warranted against any defects in material or workmanship as long as the reel exists, regardless of ownership.

PERSONAL TOUCH OUTER RIM

The drag rim on the TWIN creates tremendous breaking power, especially on the Steelhead and Big Salty reels. Touching it automatically overrides the compression drag. Lunker fish are played out by using your finger tips or light pressure with the palm or your hand. When using heavy pressure with the palm of your hand there is no limit on how much drag you can create because your hand strength become the drag's power. A glove, like a golfer's glove may be used to create more friction playing out large ocean fish.

OPEN SPOOL

Because of the open spool, bringing the line to the side allows the line to come off just like a spinning reel. You can fish straight down to whatever depth you want using a weighted fly or a heavy jig fly. We have fished down 600 feet for Halibut. You can literally fish from the top to the bottom of almost any lake. It is also awesome in rivers. This is another new feature in this reel.

LINE USED FOR BACKING

Ultra thin strong braided line take up less area on a thinner spool, this has helped make the Twin Spool Fly Reel possible. Our reel with two spools and two separate lines weigh comparable to reels with one loaded spool.

BELIEVE IT OR NOT

On this Trout Special Spool there is 100 yards of 15lb ultra-thin braided line. There is more than enough space left for 90ft 7 weight or less floating line, which is larger in diameter than sinking line.

To illustrate the spools capacity. There is 90ft 8 weight full sinking line added to the above backing. It is easy to see that heavier backing or more yardage can be used with 6 weight or less fly-line.

Something to remember:

Depending on your tippet strength, for line class competition or fishing deep in a lake you need a lot of backing. For common Fly-Fishing especially for Trout you may never see your backing even after a hundred catches or more. A lot of backing is usually for just in case you catch a large fish.

CHOOSING YOUR PERSONAL LINES

Some are using a monofilament line on one spool to fish deep with a sinking fly and on the other spool a fly line. Others are using two different floating lines, some two different sinking lines. Most commonly used is one floating and one sinking line of the same weight. You can use any two lines you prefer. When adding up all its features the **TWIN SPOOL FLY REEL** is the most **VERSATILE** fly reel in the world.

CLEANING THE REEL

If you happen to get mud, sand or other debris in between the spool and housing loosen the Drag all the way. Put your thumb's on the Drag Control and your fingers on the Spools. Now compress and hold, this will allow the spools to come away from the housing. Now submerge the entire reel in the water you are fishing in and move quickly back and forth. The debris will easily rinse out.
